

PBGYAA – Girls Basketball Player and Coach/Parent Contract

Every Player, Parent and Coach is expected to:

- Learn and respect the rules of Girls Recreation Basketball and PBGYAA guidelines.
- Show respect and courtesy to game officials, coaches and players at all times.
- Respect the game officials and refrain from questioning their decisions.
- Maintain control of your emotions and avoid actions, language and/or gestures that may be interpreted as hostile and humiliating.
- Ensure attendance at all games and practices at the required times or provide the coach with appropriate notice and reason for your absence in advance. You are making a commitment and failure to honor this commitment adversely affects teammates.
- Practice good sportsmanship and fair play. At the conclusion of a game be humble and generous in victory and proud and courteous in defeat.
- Promote the concept that basketball is merely a game and that player and coaches on other teams are opponents, not enemies.

Every Parent is expected to:

- Understand that the parents' role is one of support to the players and coaches. Parents should not engage in "coaching" from the sidelines, criticizing players on either team, coaches or game officials, BEFORE, DURING OR AFTER THE GAME.
- Cheer for your child's team in a positive manner, refraining at all times from making negative or abusive remarks about the opposing team or players on your own team. Maintain control of your emotions and avoid actions, language and/or gestures that may be interpreted as hostile or humiliating.
- Demonstrate appropriate gestures of sportsmanship at the conclusion of a game, win or lose.
- If you have any complaints, they should be made in writing to the league director.
